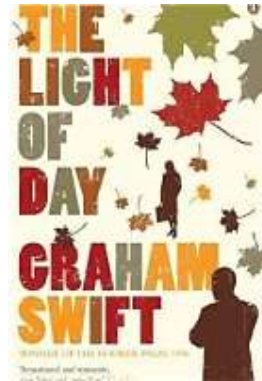


The Light of the Day
